
REGULATION OF THE MINISTER
IN THE MATTER OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT
S.B.C. 1988, C.5

1. By the authority vested in me under the provisions of section 18 of the Mineral Tenure Act, I hereby establish a mineral and placer mineral reserve over the following described land in the Clinton, Lillooet and Vancouver Mining Divisions, and the Lillooet and New Westminster Land Districts until November 1, 2001:

An area, 1500 metres wide, being 750 metres on each side of the centerline of the proposed right-of-way of the Kelly Lake - Cheekye Transmission Line as shown outlined on the attached sketch.

2. A free miner may locate or record a mineral or placer claim on all or part of the land in the mineral and placer mineral reserve subject to the conditions in section 3.

3. No free miner shall obstruct, endanger or interfere with or allow any other person to obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of a transmission line in the reserve created by section 1.
