REGULATION OF THE MINISTER OF
EMPLOYMENT AND INVESTMENT

Mineral Tenure Act

I, Dan Miller, Minister of Employment and Investment, order that

1. A reserve is established for minerals and placer minerals over the following land in the Golden Mining Division, Kootenay Land District, until November 1, 2001:
All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water more particularly described as being below the 1200 meter contour in the Kicking Horse River Valley between the Town of Golden and the west boundary of Yoho National Park as shown outlined and shaded on the attached sketch.
2. A free miner may locate or record a mineral or placer claim on all or part of the land in the reserve created by section 1 subject to the conditions in section 3.
3. A free miner shall not obstruct, endanger or interfere with or allow any other person to obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of a highway in the reserve created by section 1.
