

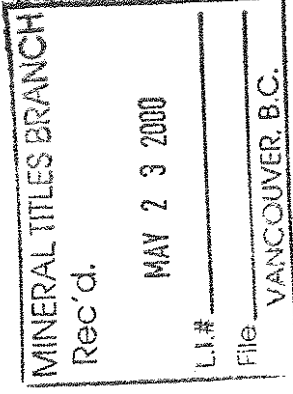

**Re: Callaghan Valley 2010 Winter Olympics Nordic Site Reserve**

Enclosed for your information is a copy of B.C. Regulation 157/2000. This Regulation accomplishes the following:

- As requested by the Lower Mainland IAMC Chair, rescinds Order in Council 3129/68, a reserve established over the site of the proposed Powder Mountain Ski Hill. This project was never proceeded with negating the need for a reserve.
- As requested by your office, establishes a reserve in the Vancouver Mining Division to ensure no staking occurs over the site of the 2010 Winter Olympics.

Also enclosed is a copy of a sketch of the area reserved and a copy of Order in Council 3129/68.

*Mineral Tenure Act*

I, Dan Miller, Minister of Energy and Mines, order that

1. The reserve established by Order in Council 3129/68, is rescinded; and,
2. A reserve is established for minerals and placer minerals over the following land in the Vancouver Mining Division, New Westminster Land District  
All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water as shown outlined and shaded on the attached sketch.
3. A free miner must not locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve created by section 2.

## Recommend

THAT pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon all that parcel or tract of land situated in the vicinity of Callaghan Creek, Vancouver Mining Division, New Westminster Land District, further described as follows:

*114*  
 Commencing at the northeast corner of S.T.L. 43713; thence due north 1 mile; thence due west 5 miles; thence due north  $3\frac{1}{2}$  miles; thence due west  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles; thence due north  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles; thence due east  $1\frac{1}{4}$  mile; thence due south  $1\frac{1}{4}$  mile; thence due north of the northeast corner of aforesaid S.T.L. 43713; thence south to said corner; thence westerly 1 mile more or less to the northwest corner of said S.T.L. 43713, being the point of commencement;

except in accordance with and subject to the following terms and conditions:

No holder of a mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, shall be entitled to any surface rights whatsoever.

No holder of a mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above, shall be entitled to any surface rights whatsoever.

No holder of a mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above, or any person exploring, developing, mining or working in any way the said mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, shall be entitled to any claim for damage which may be caused by any construction, operation and maintenance of a ski lift, road or power line or structure of any kind whatsoever, which may come into existence on the said mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease;

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT upon the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease which lies within the areas outlined above, the lands covered by any such mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease shall become and are hereby constituted a reservation under the terms of this Order.

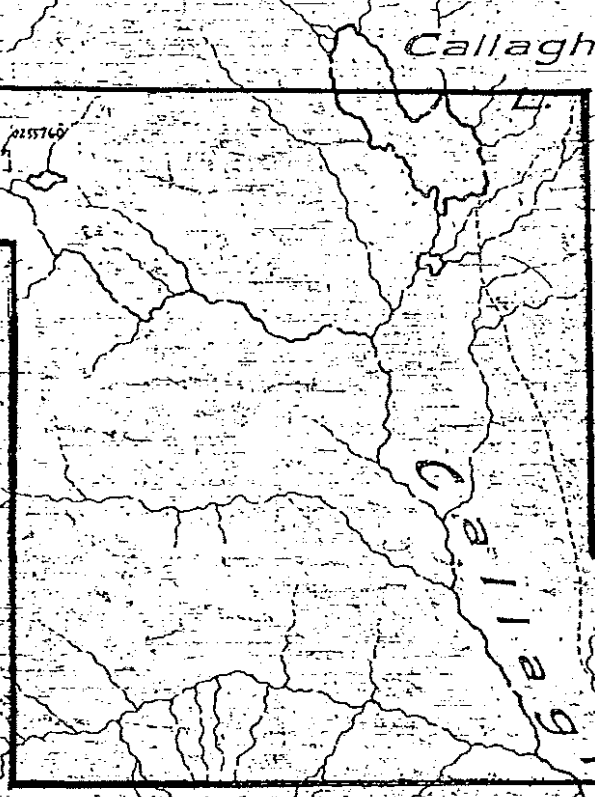
