I, Dan Miller, Minister of Energy and Mines, order that

1. A reserve be established for minerals and placer minerals over the following lands in the Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District:
An area 200 metres wide, being 100 metres on either side of the centreline of the Stanley Wagen Road as shown outlined and shaded on the attached sketch.
2. A free miner may locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve created by section 1 subject to the conditions in section 3.
3. A free miner shall not interfere with or allow any other person to interfere with a surface area that contains a cultural heritage resource.
