REGULATION OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

Mineral Tenure Act

I, Gerald Gorman, Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Energy and Mines, order that


- 1. A reserve is established for minerals and placer minerals over the following lands in the Mining Divisions and Land Districts listed in Schedule A:

All those parcels or tracts of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water as shown outlined and shaded on the attached sketches.

- 2. A free miner may locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve established by section 1 subject to the conditions listed in section 3.
- 3. A free miner must not obstruct, endanger or interfere with or allow any other person to obstruct, endanger or interfere with a paleontological site or materials of paleontological significance in the reserve established by section 1.
