Re: Spatsizi Plateau Wilderness Provincial Park Amendment Regulation Change

Enclosed for your information is a copy of B.C. Reg. 420/2003. This Regulation rescinds B.C. Reg. 325/2003 and establishes a new mineral and placer no staking reserve. As in B.C. Reg. 325/2003 the new reserve is over a portion of the Spatsizi Plateau Wilderness Provincial Park due to park boundary realignment. The sole purpose of this rescission and re-establishment is to reflect the Bill number change from 55 to 84 that accomplishes the boundary amendment of the Spatsizi Plateau Wilderness Provincial Park. Also enclosed is a copy of the map of the area reserved and a copy of B.C. Reg. 325/2003.

REGULATION OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER**


Mineral Tenure Act

I, Gerald German, Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Energy and Mines, order that:

- 1 The reserve established by B.C. Reg. 325/2003 is disestablished and B.C. Reg. 325/2003 is repealed.
- 2 For a period commencing on Royal Assent being given to the *Parks and Protected Areas Statutes Amendment Act, 2003*, Bill 84 of 2003, and ending one year after that Royal Assent is given,
 - (a) a reserve is established for minerals and placer minerals over the following lands in the Liard Mining Division, Cassiar Land District:
All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water as shown outlined and shaded on the attached sketch, and
 - (b) a free miner, other than Guardsmen Resources Inc., must not locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve established by paragraph (a).
