


**PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA**  
**REGULATION OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER**  
**Mineral Tenure Act**

I, Gerald German, Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Energy and Mines, order that:

1. B.C. Regs. 182/89, 8/97, 9/97, 353/97, 143/2001, 54/2002, 8/58, 97/86, 205/95, 168/2000, 184/2000, 183/2000, 109/2001, 249/91; and,
2. B.C. Reg. 204/2000 is amended by repealing Section 2 and substituting the following:
  - 2 A free miner may locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve established by section 1 subject to the conditions listed in section 3.
  - 3 A free miner must not obstruct, endanger or interfere with or allow any other person to obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of a highway in the reserve established by section 1.
