REGULATION OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

Mineral Tenure Act

I, Gerald German, Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Energy and Mines, order that

- 1. A reserve is established for minerals and placer minerals over the following lands in the Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District:

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water as shown outlined and shaded on the attached sketch entitled Valemount Resort - Site 2.

- 2. A free miner may locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve established by section 1 subject to the conditions listed in section 3.
- 3. A free miner or an agent of a free miner must not obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of a Controlled Recreation Area in the reserve established by section 1.
