


**PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA**  
**REGULATION OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER**  
**Mineral Tenure Act**

I, Gerald German, Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Energy and Mines, order that:

1. Orders in Council 2221/54 and 2224/54, and B.C. Regs. 279/91, 471/92, 113/85, 64/94 and 234/69 are rescinded; and,
2. B.C. Reg. 10/86 is amended by repealing section 2 and substituting the following:
  - 2 A free miner may locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve established by section 1 subject to the conditions listed in section 3.
  - 3 A free miner must not obstruct, endanger or interfere with or allow any other person to obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of a pulp mill in the reserve established by section 1.
