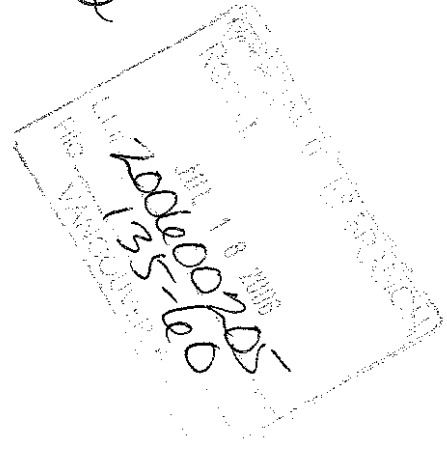

REGULATION OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

Mineral Tenure Act and Coal Act

1. Gerald German, Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources order that B.C. Reg. 172/2004 is amended by repealing sections 2 and 3 and substituting the following:

2. A free miner must not register a mineral or placer claim in the reserve established by section 1.
3. The areas described in section 1 are established as a coal land reserve.

REGULATION OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

Mineral Tenure Act

I, Gerald German, Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Energy and Mines, order that

1. A mineral reserve is established over the following lands in the Vancouver Mining Division, New Westminster Land District:


All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water as shown outlined and shaded on the attached sketch.

- 2. A free miner may locate or record a mineral claim in the reserve established by section 1 subject to the conditions listed in section 3.
- 3. A free miner must not obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of a highway in the reserve established by section 1.
