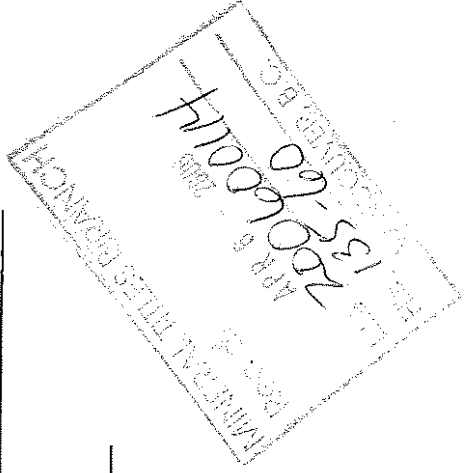



recommend that pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereunto enabling no free miner who locates a mineral claim or placer claim and obtains a record thereof or who obtains a mineral lease or a placer lease upon Lot 2350<sup>0</sup>, Similkameen Division of Yale Land District, after the approval of this Order shall be entitled to the use and possession of the surface of that claim or lease for mining purposes notwithstanding that the surface rights are vested in Her Majesty the Queen in the right of Her Province of British Columbia or Her agents or servants.
