REGULATION OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

Mineral Tenure Act and Coal Act

I, Mark Messmer, Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources, order as follows:

- (a) the reserve for minerals and placer minerals established by B.C. Reg. 26/95 as "Two Springs" is cancelled;
(b) Schedule A to B.C. Reg. 26/95 is amended by deleting the following item and the sketch corresponding to that item:
TWO SPRINGS
Lillooet and Kamloops Mining Divisions
Lillooet and Kamloops Division of Yale Land Districts;
(c) the coal land reserve established by B.C. Reg. 167/2004 over site number 333277, "Two Springs", is cancelled;
(d) for the purpose of continuing the mineral reserve referred to in paragraph (a) and the coal land reserve referred to in paragraph (c), the Mineral and Coal Land Reserve (No Mineral Claim Registrations) Regulation, B.C. Reg. 171/2011, is amended by adding the following site to the Table:
