

PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA

REGULATION OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

Mineral Tenure Act and Coal Act

I, Mark Messmer, Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources, order as follows:

- (a) the prohibition established by B.C. Reg. 19/61 is revoked, any mineral or placer reserve established by B.C. Reg. 19/61 is cancelled and B.C. Reg. 19/61 is repealed;
(b) the reserve for minerals and placer minerals, and the coal land reserve, established by B.C. Reg. 342/98 is cancelled and B.C. Reg. 342/98 is repealed;
(c) the Mineral Land Reserve (No Mineral Claim Registrations) Regulation, B.C. Reg. 71/2010, is amended by adding the following site to the Table:
