

# Adding BC government layers to the Regional Mines Public Engagement Portal

The Regional Mines Public Engagement Portal shows mining applications that are open for public comment. Some layers are pre-loaded onto the application. If you wish to add additional layers from the BC Geographic Warehouse (BCGW) follow the instructions below.

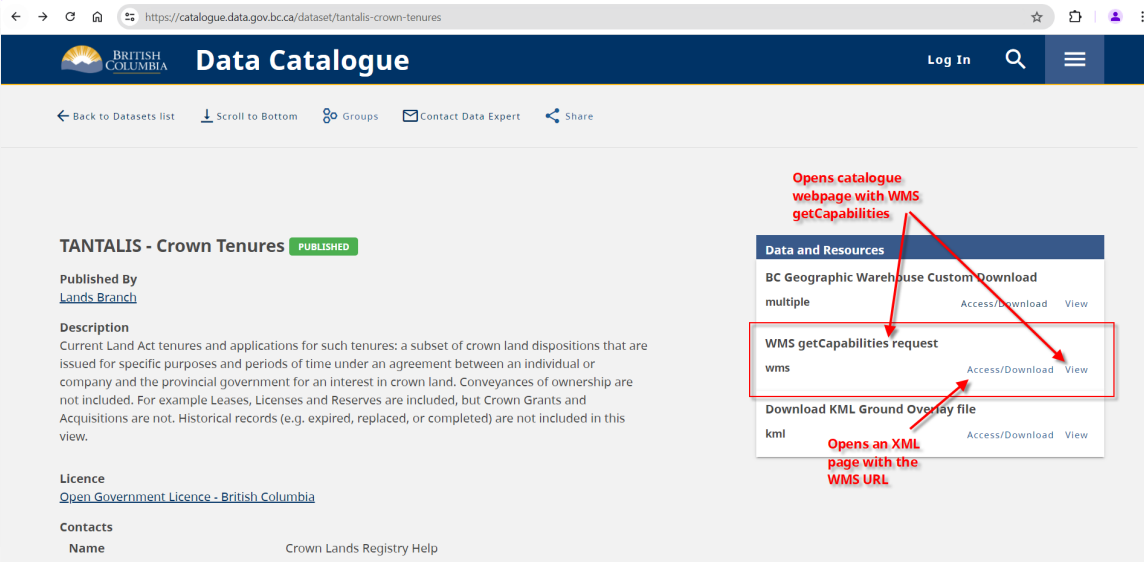

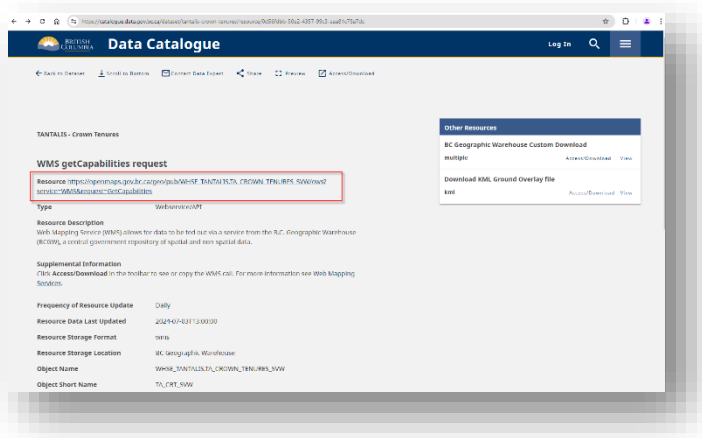

## Determine what layer you would like to visualize

1. View information in the [BC Data Catalogue](#)
  - For example, Tantalus – Crown Tenures:  
<https://catalogue.data.gov.bc.ca/dataset/tantalus-crown-tenures>
2. Select WMS getCapabilities request and copy the getCapabilities URL

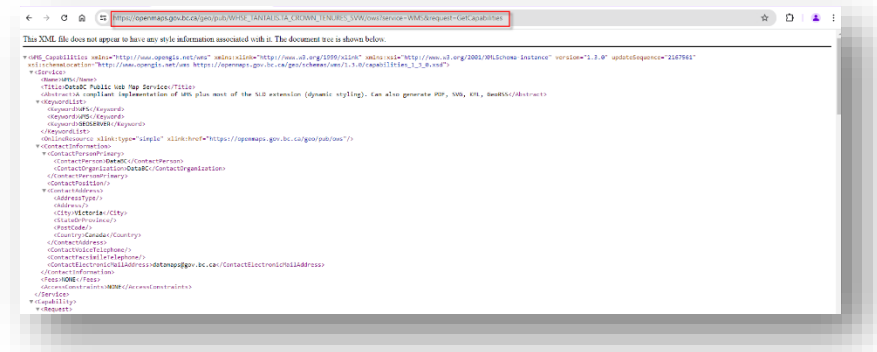


Click the **title header** or **View** to get the WMS getCapabilities request catalogue webpage.

Click the Resource URL link to open the XML page to copy the URL, or

Right click and **copy link address**



Click the **Access/Download** link to open up the XML page for the request

Copy the WMS URL

## Open up a web browser with the Regional Public Engagement Portal address

1. Open a web browser to the [Regional Mines Public Engagement Portal](#)
2. **Minimize** the legend to access the map tools
3. Click the **Add Data** tool in the lower left corner of the map area

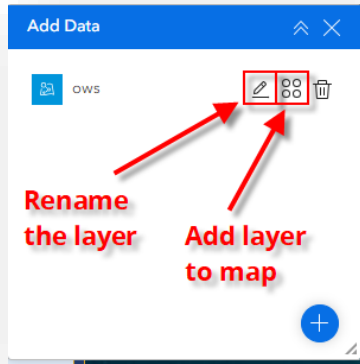


#### 4. Add Data pop-up appears

- Click the **Click to add data** button
- In the second Add data pop-up, select the **URL** tab
- From the **Type** drop-down menu, select **WMS OGC Web Service**
- In the **URL** field paste the getCapabilities URL from step 2 in the data to visualize section
- Click the **Add** button
- Click the **Done** button



5. Add and rename your newly added layer to the map



- Click the pencil to **Edit** the layer name

Enter the new name in the field, hit enter

- Click the 4 circles **Action** button

Select **Add to map**

6. Close the Add Data pop-up box by clicking the **X** in the top right corner

7. Select the **Layers** button to see the newly added layer. Buttons are located in the top right of the map area.

- Zoom in on the map to have the spatial features appear
