**SUBJECT: 2013-2014 Amended Publication Dates for Notice of Public Tender for Dispositions of Petroleum and Natural Gas Rights**

Due to operational considerations the publication dates for the next seven Notices of Public Tender have been amended. The Notice of Public Tender will be published one week later from April 2014 to September 2014. This does not affect the Closing Date for Postings, the Withdraw/Postpone/Revise Deadline, or the Disposition Date.

Notice is given that competition for the right to explore and develop Crown petroleum and natural gas resources in British Columbia, will be held on the disposition dates shown below. This notice supersedes Information Letter OGD-13-03.

The new publication dates for the Notice of Public Tender are shown in **bold**.

Postings will be received up to and including the respective Closing Date as listed in the schedule. Re-Postings will be received up to and including the respective No Bid or No Acceptable Bids (NB or NAB) Closing Date as listed in the schedule. Late submissions cannot be accepted.

Requests to withdraw, postpone or revise postings will not be considered after the withdraw/postpone/revise deadline. Only the original requester can initiate a withdraw/postpone/revise request for parcels they requested for disposition. A withdrawal request is made with the intent to remove a parcel from being considered for disposition. A postponement request is made with the intent to move the requested parcel to a future disposition date. Revise requests can involve changes to the tenure type, the requested rights, or the configuration of the requested parcel. The reconfiguration of a parcel must not result in new lands that were not part of the original request being added to the parcel. The right to approve withdraw/postpone/revise requests is reserved.

In the event a parcel offered for disposition receives NB or NAB on the day of the disposition, those lands can be requested to be re-posted for the next available disposition of Crown petroleum and natural gas rights as the Disposition Dates Schedule permits. Requests to re-post NB or NAB parcels will be received up to and including the NB or NAB Closing Date as listed in the schedule. The right to approve re-posting requests is reserved.

The parcel description for a parcel requested for re-posting due to NB or NAB must be identical to the description of the parcel receiving No Bids or No Acceptable Bids. No changes to the NB or NAB parcel description will be accepted. Requests for re-postings must be submitted via facsimile in accordance with Instructions for Submitting a Posting or Re-Posting Request.

**Re-posting requests cannot be made using Petroleum Titles Online.**
