## Re: Christmas Tree Cutting Requirements – Personal Use Skeena Stikine Resource District

- 1. Christmas tree(s) may only be cut from areas of Crown land
  - (a) on power line rights-of-way or
  - (b) forest road rights-of-way.
- **Note:** Power line rights-of-way are defined by the cleared area immediately under the power line itself. Road rights-of-way are defined as three metres (10 feet) beyond the edge of the ditch or excavated portion of the road bank or fill slope.
- 2. **CUTTING** of Christmas trees is **NOT** permitted in the following areas:
  - (a) Forest plantations on harvested cutblocks
  - (b) Parks
  - (c) Private land without the owner's authorization
  - (d) Individuals may take up to three (3) Christmas trees for their own personal use. Make sure it is the tree you want before you cut it. Do not cut a large tree only to use the top portion. Do not leave branches and lower portions of the cut tree alongside roads or in ditches.
  - (e) Cutting Christmas trees free of charge is strictly for personal use; **trees must not be offered for sale.**
