



Wind Power Application Requirements List

The following requirements are part of the application and must be provided. Incomplete applications will be returned to the applicant.

In addition to the General Application Requirements included on the Application Form, the following items are required for Wind Power applications.

Investigative Phase

FOR AN INVESTIGATIVE LICENCE

- An Investigation Plan

Development and Operating Phase

FOR A MULTI TENURE INSTRUMENT OR INDIVIDUAL TENURES

- A Development Plan, signed and dated, which includes the following:

Information on project construction, operation, monitoring, and decommissioning. Information requirements pertaining to the development plan are available in the Development Plan Information Requirements (see link below)

Description of the environmental and socio-economic details of the proposed project, and ways that impacts will be avoided or mitigated.

The Development Plan provides critical information to assess the proposed project and determine whether authorizations will be issued under the relevant legislations. The Province has developed a standardized suite of information requirements necessary to complete a Development Plan. These requirements are available for download from:
