Re: Vanderhoof Access Management Plan for Forest Recreation

The Integrated Land Management Bureau in collaboration with a wide range of stakeholders, public and government agencies including: the Ministry of Forests and Range; Ministry of Tourism, Sports and the Arts; and the Ministry of Environment, has completed a review and update process for the Vanderhoof Access Management Plan. Revisions to the plan are in response to the mountain pine beetle epidemic and associated risk to values in the Vanderhoof LRMP.

The *Vanderhoof Access Management Plan for Forest Recreation* provides the most current information for the management of access in the Vanderhoof LRMP planning area. This updated plan was developed through an iterative and transparent process and provides choices and flexibility for implementation and continuous improvement.

This policy plan is endorsed by the Regional Executive Director of the Integrated Land Management Bureau and is being provided to you for consideration and implementation.
