Notice of Rescission of Permission to Occupy Crown Land

The Ministry of Water, Land and Resource Stewardship (the “Ministry”) is responsible for the management of most Crown land in British Columbia, under the authority of the *Land Act* RSBC 1996 Ch. 245.

Access to Crown land may be through the issuance of tenures under the *Land Act*, or through a permission granted by the Ministry to members of the public under the *Land Act* Permissions Policy (the “Policy”). The Permission to use Crown land is a bare licence which may be limited or rescinded to a greater or lesser extent, from place to place and from time to time.

As further assessment(s) and monitoring along the Chilcotin River corridor is required, the Ministry is rescinding permission for all transitory activities, as defined in policy, on Crown land. For clarity, this closure *does not* apply to ongoing Investigative Assessments.

Access to the area, as outlined in red on the attached map, is hereby rescinded effective September 18, 2024 to January 31, 2025

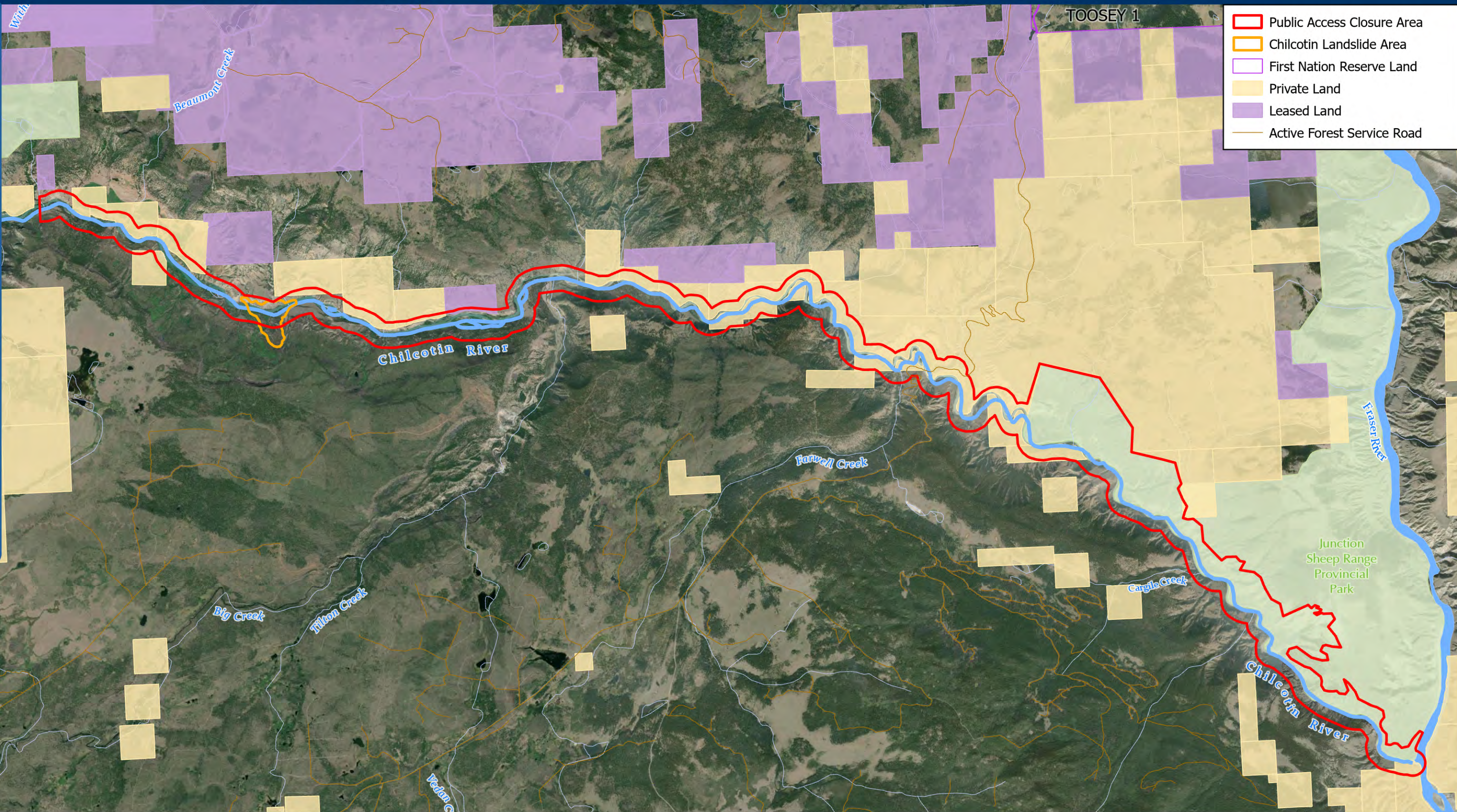
Use and occupation of Crown land without lawful authority is contrary to the *Land Act* and is considered trespass. Persons found using or occupying the Close area for the purpose stated above may face administrative remedies or trespass charges under Section 59 and 60 of the *Land Act*.
