ORDER TO ESTABLISH, AMEND AND REPEAL SCENIC AREAS WITHIN THE
LAKES TIMBER SUPPLY AREA PORTION OF THE NADINA FOREST DISTRICT

Pursuant to section 7(1) of the *Government Actions Regulation (GAR)* of the *Forest and Range Practices Act (FRPA)*, the scenic areas identified below and on the attached map titled: *Nadina Forest District (Lakes Timber Supply Area) – Scenic Areas, March 15, 2010* are established or amended as scenic areas.


Scenic areas previously made known by the Lakes District Manager under the *Forest Practices Code of British Columbia Act* and grandparented under section 180 of FRPA are now cancelled and replaced with the scenic areas listed below and shown on the map attached to this Order.

This Order takes effect on April 1, 2010.
