

MAP 8: Land Use Designations

LEGEND

Resource Management Zones

- Protected Area (13%): includes National and Provincial Parks, Ecological Reserves.
- Special Management (8%): Areas whose management priorities must incorporate identified primary environmental, recreational, and cultural/heritage values.
- General Management (31%): Areas managed under standard integrated resource management strategies of the Forest Practices Code.
- Enhanced Forestry (24%): Areas managed to produce higher volumes and values of timber while respecting environmental protection standards of the Forest Practices Code.
- Agriculture (3%): Areas that can accommodate viable and sustainable food production; includes all land within the Agricultural Land Reserve and areas under cultivation that are not within the Reserve.
- Settlement (3%): Areas of human settlement; including the existing concentration of settlements as well as First Nation Reserves larger than 250 hectares.
- Private (18%): Managed Forest Lands outside a Tree Farm Licence; includes small areas of other private and Crown land uses.
- Coastal Planning Units (General Management)
- Planning Area Boundary
- Clayoquot Land Use Decision Area Boundary
Special Management and General Management zones within this area are subject to the recommendations of the Scientific Panel for Sustainable Forest Practices (1995).
