

## OVERVIEW

The Ministry of Forests (FOR) will be contracting out work to rebuild a section of the Driftwood FSR north of Fort St James from 15.1km to 16.7km. The current road configuration does not meet the desired road design and must be re-worked to meet the required vertical alignment. This project will be placed on BC Bid as an open invitation for qualified contractors under competition number EN26PGN337
