

## Structure Inspections and Map Information

### Inspections

Inspections are current only to the date of the inspection.

It is incumbent for anyone planning to use a structure to conduct an inspection prior to any use or planned use to ensure that the user has a complete and current understanding of the condition of any structure.

The Government of BC and its agents accept no liability for any decisions or assumptions based on the inspection reports.

The Ministry of Forests welcomes any opportunity to perform joint inspections on any of the Ministry of Forests' structures prior to use by any entity that requires the use of those structures and road systems.

**Any use of Forest Service Roads requires the permission of the District Manager. This is usually in the form of a Road Use Permit which can be obtained from the District Manager for the local Forest District.**

Structures are inspected on 1, 2 or 3 year rotation. Inspection rotation is set by reviewing engineer. Some sites no longer require inspections, but the inspection report shows last inspection for all sites. List is sorted by Project Number then by Branch Number and then by Site Number.

### Maps

- Maps are from the available list from 2022/03/10
- Maps show both Site Number and Structure Number
- If only Site Number is shown, the structure has been removed
- Maps are geographically located and can be used with Avenza
