How do I access the supply arrangements?

- Supply arrangements are found on the [Goods and Services Catalogue](#)
- Each supply arrangement page will include information on ordering, supplier contact coordinates and a copy of the supply arrangement, including terms and conditions.
- To be eligible your organization needs to have signed a CSA Access Agreement with the Province. Please review the [CSA Users list](#) on the Goods and Services Catalogue. You'll probably find that your organization has already signed a CSA Access Agreement in order to access other supply arrangements. If not, review the [Supply Arrangements FAQ](#) page or [email the Procurement Services Branch](#) to request access to the CSAs. This agreement is all you need to order through any of our supply arrangements eligible to the broader public sector.
