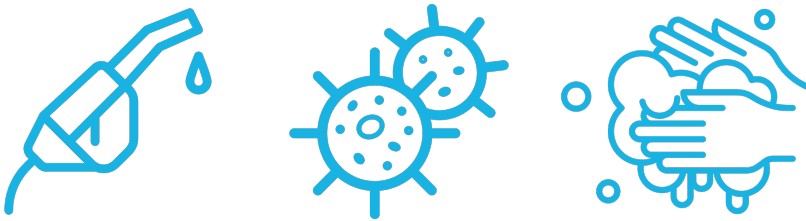


6 TIPS FOR SMART FUELING

Fuel pump handles are already notorious for their lack of cleanliness. Another common source of contamination? ATM buttons – similar to the keypad at the pump. So how do you stay safe when fueling up amidst COVID-19 risks?



FOLLOW THESE SIX TIPS TO HELP AVOID CROSS-CONTAMINATION AT THE PUMP.

- Wear disposable gloves and discard prior to getting back in your vehicle
- Wipe down fuel pump handle with sanitizing wipes
- Avoid using credit card terminals when possible, opt for mobile pay options
- Maintain a safe social distance from other people while at the pump
- Avoid touching your face, and use approved hand sanitizer once back in the vehicle
- Wash your hands as soon as you can, following recommended method

A hygiene study conducted in six U.S. cities by consumer product giant Kimberly-Clark discovered that 71 percent of fuel pumps carry high levels of contamination, holding 11,000 times more bacteria than a home toilet.
