

- (b) the Residential Care Regulation, B.C. Reg. 96/2009, is amended as set out in the attached Schedule 2.



## SCHEDULE 1

- 1 *Section 1 of Schedule H of the Child Care Licensing Regulation, B.C. Reg. 332/2007, is amended by repealing the definition of “choking” and substituting the following:*

“**choking**” means a choking incident involving a person in care that requires

- (a) first aid,
- (b) emergency care by a medical practitioner or nurse practitioner, or
- (c) transfer to a hospital; .

## SCHEDULE 2

- 1 *Section 1 of Schedule D of the Residential Care Regulation, B.C. Reg. 96/2009, is amended by repealing the definitions of “choking” and “aggressive or unusual behaviour” and substituting the following:*

“**choking**” means a choking incident involving a person in care that requires

- (a) first aid,
- (b) emergency care by a medical practitioner or nurse practitioner, or
- (c) transfer to a hospital;

“**aggressive or unusual behaviour**” means aggressive or unusual behaviour by a person in care towards another person, including another person in care, that

- (a) has not been appropriately assessed in the care plan of the person in care, and
- (b) is not aggression between persons in care within the meaning of this Schedule; .

- 2 *Section 1 of Schedule D is amended by adding the following definition:*

“**aggression between persons in care**” means aggressive behaviour by a person in care towards another person in care that causes an injury that requires

- (a) first aid,
- (b) emergency care by a medical practitioner or nurse practitioner, or
- (c) transfer to a hospital; .
