

John Houston (the “Respondent”)

The Respondent was alleged to have acted incompetently and breached a term or condition of their license by failing to develop an adequate extrication plan for the Patient, who had collapsed and reported feeling dizzy, and failing to extricate the Patient to the ambulance in a safe manner (the “admissions”). On October 26, 2023, the Respondent admitted to the allegations and resolved the disciplinary matter by way of an Alternative Dispute Resolution agreement with the Emergency Medical Assistants Licensing Board (the “Agreement”). The Respondent is required to complete a course in Professional Responsibilities in Paramedicine and complete a clinical consultation with a Branch-appointed resource person to discuss the issues involved in the admissions within 90 days of the Agreement.
