

Nora Laharty (the “Respondent”)

The Respondent was alleged to have acted incompetently and breached a term or condition of their licence by failing to develop an adequate extrication plan for the patient, who had collapsed and reported feeling dizzy, failing to extricate the patient to the ambulance in a safe manner, and failing to act professionally by not treating the patient with respect and empathy (the “admissions”). On April 12, 2023, the Respondent admitted to the allegations and resolved the disciplinary matter by way of an Alternative Dispute Resolution agreement with the Emergency Medical Assistants Licensing Board (the “Agreement”). The Respondent was required to complete a clinical consultation with a Branch-appointed resource person to discuss the issues involved in the admissions within 90 days of the Agreement.

As of August 23, 2023, the Respondent has completed all requirements of the Agreement and consequently the complaint file is closed.
