Alternative Dispute Resolution Agreement, dated May 22, 2024

On May 22, 2024, the Emergency Medical Assistants Licensing Board (the "Board"), pursuant to Rule 7.1 (c) of the Rules for Complaints, Investigations and Disciplinary Hearings, resolved the matter with the agreement of the Respondent by way of an alternative dispute resolution agreement (the "Agreement"). As part of the Agreement, the Respondent acknowledges and admits to acting incompetently and breaching a term and condition of their licence on March 31, 2023 by: giving tranexamic acid ("TXA") to the Patient who did not meet the treatment guidelines for administering TXA and failing to consult with a paramedic specialist or medical oversight advisor before doing so. Further, as part of the Agreement, the Respondent agreed to complete up to five (5) consultation meetings with a clinical advisor, and prepare for the consultation meetings by reviewing the drug monograph for TXA, and the major trauma guidelines (H-01 Principals of Major Trauma) all of which must be completed within 90 days of the Respondent receiving a copy of the signed Agreement.

On October 15, 2024, the Board determined the Respondent has complied with the terms of the ADR Agreement. Accordingly, the complaint file is now closed.
