

BC Jurisprudence Examination

All licensing candidates at the emergency medical responder, primary care paramedic, infant transport team, advanced care paramedic, or critical care paramedic level are required to successfully complete the jurisprudence examination. Candidates are required to complete the jurisprudence exam **every time** they apply for a new licence category. The online jurisprudence exam may be completed anywhere a candidate has internet access.

After you have completed the exam, your results will be available immediately. If you are unsuccessful on your first attempt you may re-attempt the exam at any time. If you are unsuccessful on your second attempt, you will be required to wait 5 days before your final attempt at the exam. Please ensure you review the [Applicant Guide to the B.C.
