1. Policy Rationale & Purpose:

Historically the branch has experienced a high volume of applicants that have not successfully completed the examination requirements. These applicants typically have had at least one attempt at the practical examinations but have either not attempted or failed the online written and jurisprudence examinations.

The purpose of this policy is to outline the order examinations are required to be completed in when practical examinations are required.

2. Policy Scope

This policy applies to all examination candidates that are required to successfully complete written, jurisprudence and practical examinations.

3. Exemptions

This policy does not apply to candidates that are part of a BCEHS special examination session.

4. Policy Statement:

Examinations are required to be successfully completed in the following order

- a. Written and jurisprudence examinations
- b. Practical examinations

Practical examinations will not be scheduled until a candidate has successfully completed the online written and jurisprudence examinations.
