Dear Registered Assisted Living Operator:

Recent changes to the *Community Care and Assisted Living Act* (CCALA) will require the Assisted Living Registry to publicly post basic information about registered assisted living residences by September 1, 2018. Section 25.4 of the CCALA defines the basic information to be posted as the operator's name, business name and the address at which a residence operates.

Section [25.4 \(2\)](#) of the CCALA provides for an exemption from the address requirement if a registrant is of the view that publishing the address of their assisted living residence would present a risk to the health or safety of the persons being provided accommodation and assisted living services.

If you believe having your address posted on the Ministry of Health Assisted Living Registry website would pose a risk to the health and safety of the persons to whom you provide services, you may submit the attached exemption request form to the Registry at [Hlth.assistedlivingregistry@gov.bc.ca](mailto:Hlth.assistedlivingregistry@gov.bc.ca) prior to September 1, 2018.
