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This Standard of Practice is made under the authority of section (4)(1)(e) of the *Community Care and Assisted Living Act* (CCALA), which provides that the Director of Licensing may:

(e) specify policies and standards of practice for all community care facilities or a class of community care facilities....

## **Relevant Legislation:**

## CCALA - Standards to be Maintained

7(1) A licensee must do all of the following:...

(b) operate the community care facility in a manner that will promote the health, safety and dignity of persons in care....

## **Residential Care Regulations – Operations**

49(1)A licensee must require all persons admitted to a community care facility to comply with the Province's immunization and tuberculosis control programs.

## **Standard of Practice:**

- 1. Licensees of Community Care Facilities must:
  - a. Review the immunization status of each person in care upon admission, and regularly thereafter.
  - b. Keep clear and up-to-date records of the immunization status of each person in care.
  - c. Provide information to persons in care regarding the benefits of immunization including pneumococccal, annual influenza and tetanus-diphtheria if appropriate.
  - d. Consult with the Medical Health Officer of their health authority with respect to vaccine programs which should be offered to persons in care.

- e. Develop a care plan, to include individual outbreak prevention and control policies, for each resident on admission.
- f. Develop general facility outbreak prevention and control policies as recommended by the health authority's Medical Health Officer.
