



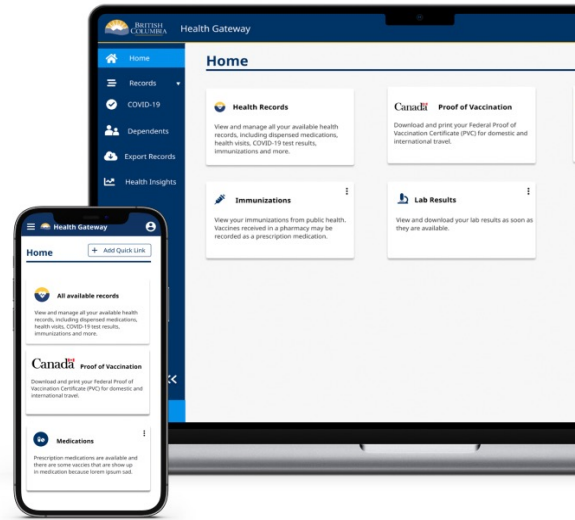
Get your immunization records online

Health Gateway provides secure and convenient access to your health records. Anyone 12 years or older can use it.

Use Health Gateway to:

- Download or print your immunization records for school or other places that require it. Information is available back to 2009
- Find out when you should get your next immunization

Parents and guardians can use the Health Gateway website to see immunization records for their children under 12.



How it works

- 1 Choose web or mobile.** Go to the Health Gateway website at healthgateway.gov.bc.ca. Or you can use the Health Gateway mobile app.
- 2 Log in.** Use your BC Services Card account to securely log in to Health Gateway. Find out how at id.gov.bc.ca/account
- 3 View your immunizations.** Use the **Filter** option to view a list of just your immunization records. If anything is missing, you can update your records at immunizationrecord.gov.bc.ca
- 4 Export records.** This feature is only available on the Health Gateway website. Go to **Menu > Export > Immunizations**. Choose the PDF file type. You can print the file or save it for later.
