LOCUM OPPORTUNITIES

With only a short-term commitment, you can experience practice in rural settings and receive an attractive compensation package.

The Rural Family Practice Maternity Locum Program (RFPMLP), established by the Joint Standing Committee on Rural Issues (JSC), assists RFPMLP working in eligible rural BC communities to secure subsidized vacation relief. A & B communities supported by the Rural Obstetrics and Maternity Network (ROAM) are entitled to 35 days for each permanent physician or permanent vacancy. The RFPMLP offers locum assignments for a minimum of 2 days to a maximum of 35 days.

THE COMPENSATION PACKAGE

- A guaranteed daily rate based on the community's level of isolation (see chart below) for each day you are on assignment.
- All travel expenses to and from your assignment, plus a travel honorarium of up to \$1,500 per return trip.

OTHER BENEFITS

- No payment hassles – you will receive payment from the Medical Services Plan every two weeks.
- Responsibility for submitting claims to the Medical Services Plan rests with the office of the physician you are replacing.
- Our helpful staff arranges all of your assignments and assists you with your hospital privileges, in collaboration with health authorities.
- The program will reimburse your eligible travel and accommodation expenses.
- Where applicable, you are eligible to receive payment for on-call MOCAP from the Health Authority/Host Physician.
- You will be retained as an independent contractor with the Program – not as an employee.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Eligible to practice in BC.
- A resident of BC through the duration of the locum assignment.
- A member in good standing of the Canadian Medical Protective Association or be covered by alternative medical malpractice insurance in British Columbia, College of Physicians and Surgeons BC and the regional health authority.
- A current certificate in Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS); certificate in Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) preferred, but not mandatory.
