SECTION 4 - CRITERIA FOR INDEFINITE COVERAGE

Coverage as an adjunct to standard of care therapy* to reduce the risk of end-stage kidney disease and a sustained decrease in estimated glomerular filtration rate (eGFR), and cardiovascular death, non-fatal myocardial infarction, and hospitalization for heart failure in adult patient who meets ALL criteria below:

- Criteria for indefinite coverage including: Patient has both type 2 diabetes (T2D) and chronic kidney disease (CKD) with an estimated glomerular filtration rate (eGFR) of at least 25ml/min/1.73m2; Patient has an albuminuria level of at least 3 mg/mmol; Patient must be receiving maximally tolerated doses of both ACEi or ARB and SGLT2i; Patient does not have chronic heart failure (CHF) NYHA class II-IV; Patient is not on concurrent treatment with a different Mineralocorticoid Receptor Antagonist (MRA); Treatment is prescribed by a prescriber with experience in the diagnosis and management of patients with T2D and CKD.

* Standard of care therapy in patients with CKD and T2D who have persistent albuminuria, is defined as maximally tolerated doses of an ACEi or ARB, in combination with an SGLT2i, unless SGLT2i are contraindicated or not tolerated.
