## PharmaNet Cheat Sheet: COVID-19 Vaccines

# BRITISH COLUMBIA

#### **IMPORTANT:**

- Record immunizations in PharmaNet on the day given
- PharmaNet data is extracted by the Provincial Immunization Registry (PIR) every day at 9 pm
- If you need to make a change to a claim, do this before the next 9 pm extract. Only change a claim outside of this time frame if the wrong PIN was used, and back-date to the service date (if it is not backdated, a second record is made in PIR)
- Prescriber should be the administering pharmacist
- Use the PIN assigned by PharmaCare

#### Before administration

- Read the COVID-19 Immunization Guide for Pharmacies at bcpharmacy.ca
- Verify patient ID. Update patient demographics in PharmaNet if needed
- If you have CareConnect, check PIR for prior dose before administering a vaccine
- Patient interviews are not 100% reliable

### CareConnect and PIR

To access PIR, you need CareConnect. It's anticipated all pharmacists will need to access the PIR to administer dose 2.

Anyone in B.C. during the pandemic can receive the COVID-19 vaccine. They do not need to be a B.C. resident or have MSP coverage. They do not need to be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.

## Directions for Use (Sig) field

#### Immunization dispense

Enter lot number and injection arm (either RIGHT or LEFT) separated by an underscore \_\_\_\_

Do not enter other characters or "Lot", "Arm", expiry, IM, etc.

**Note:** When you submit a claim, PharmaNet will indicate that it is **not** a benefit and will reject the claim. This is expected. You will still be reimbursed for the service. Do not reverse the claim.

## Inventory received, wasted, transferred, or returned

Use your O-Med PHN and submit under the vaccine PIN.

Record on the day received or wasted.

Quantity = total volume in mL. Should be a multiple of the vaccine dose (e.g. 2 doses of 0.5 mL = 1mL wasted)

Follow Sig field entry instructions in table.

## Wastage

To minimize wastage, at end of day, vaccinate age-eligible patients with remaining doses. See table for entry options.

## Transfer

For transferring product between stores, use the 3-character PEC (e.g. A01) of the store you are transferring to, or the PEC of the store you are transferring from. See table for entry options.
