Your options under the program

Product	Coverage	What PharmaCare Pays
Prescription drugs — bupropion (Zyban®) or varenicline (Champix®)	A single continuous course of treatment lasting up to 12 weeks (84 days) in a row once every calendar year.	Depending on the rules of your PharmaCare plan, PharmaCare may pay all, part, or none of the cost.
Nicorette Rx gum — <i>Ultra Fresh Mint only</i>	Up to 9 boxes of 105 pieces of gum over the course of 12 weeks (84 days) in a row, once every calendar year (28 days' supply per fill).	Entire cost
Nicoderm Rx patch	Up to 12 boxes of 7 patches over the course of 12 weeks (84 days) in a row, once every calendar year (28 days' supply per fill).	Entire cost
Nicorette Rx lozenges	Up to 9 bottles of 88 lozenges over the course of 12 weeks (84 days) in a row, once every calendar year (28 days' supply per fill).	Entire cost
Nicorette Rx inhaler	Up to 12 boxes of 42 cartridges over the course of 12 weeks (84 days) in a row, once every calendar year (28 days' supply per fill).	Entire cost
