### Disclaimer

Working Group members are selected by the Guidelines and Protocols Advisory Committee (GPAC) and complete an initial conflict of interest review. The working group undertakes initial research, evaluates levels of evidence, and prepares a draft guideline in a common template format. Drafts are edited in a robust multi-step process including requests for commentary from several hundred medical practitioners, pharmacists, health managers and other stakeholders. Input from these reviews is evaluated and incorporated by GPAC into a final draft that is sent to the Doctors of BC Board for information. The final draft is presented and discussed at the Medical Services Commission, which upon its approval then owns the published guideline.
