## SCHEDULE

The bylaws of the College of Occupational Therapists of British Columbia made under the authority of the *Health Professions Act* are amended as follows:

1. Section 30.(1) is repealed and replaced by the following:

30.(1) The board must give written notice of an annual or extraordinary general meeting to every registrant at least thirty (30) days prior to the meeting.

2. Section 30 is amended by adding section 30.(4):

30.(4) Notice of an annual or extraordinary general meeting shall be deemed valid if it is posted on the College website and:

- (a) mailed by regular mail to each registrant at the registrant's last known address recorded in the College files; or
- (b) for those registrants who have provided the College with an electronic mail address, transmitted by electronic mail to each registrant at the registrant's last known electronic mail address recorded in the College files
