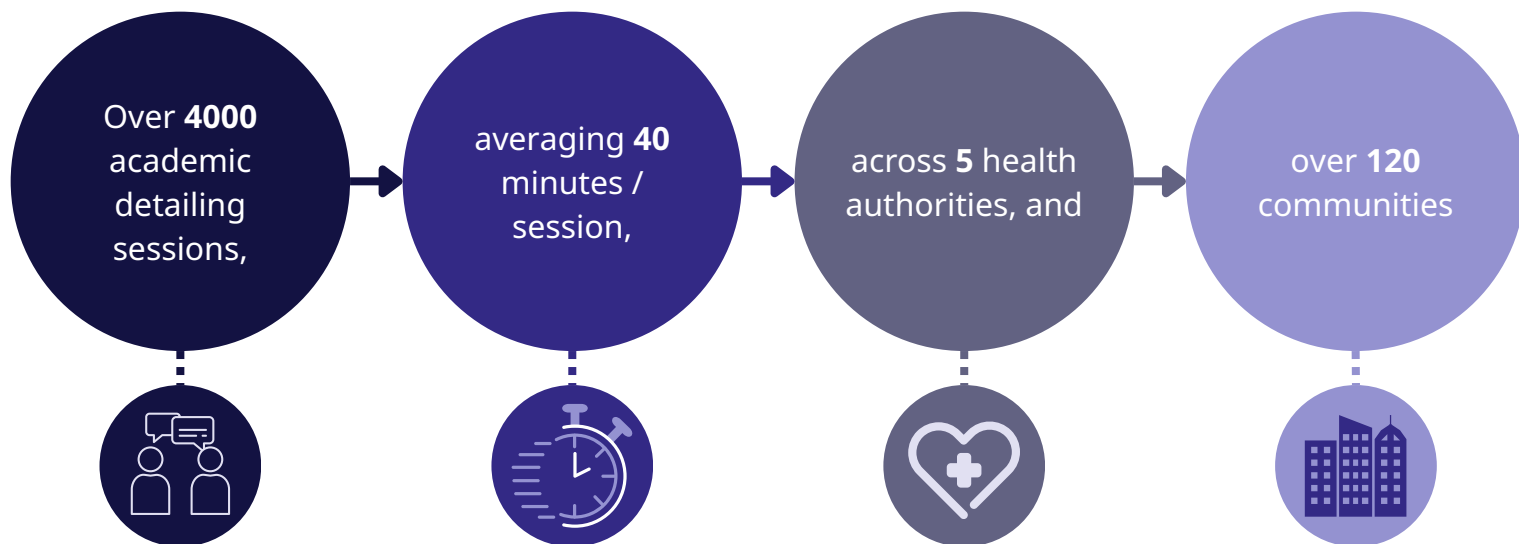


## PAD's reach in B.C.

Between 2022 and 2025, PAD pharmacists held over 4000 academic detailing sessions, averaging 40 minutes per session, across 5 health authorities, and over 120 communities

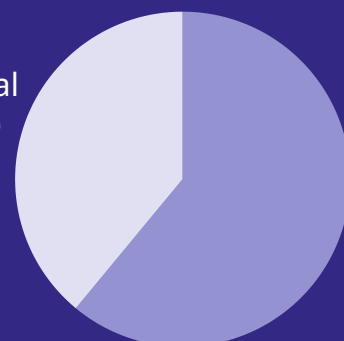

## Session type

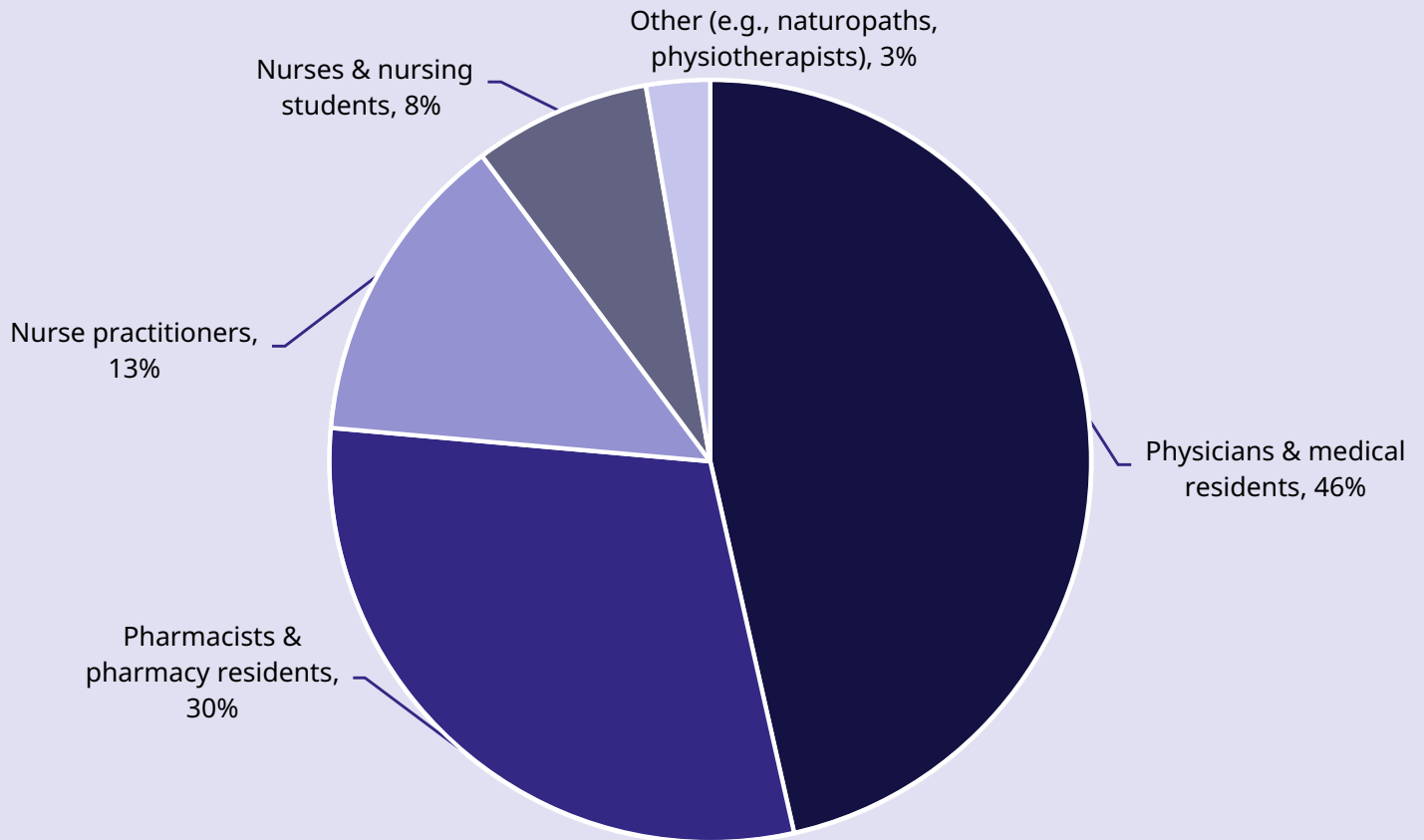
Most sessions were in person (61%)

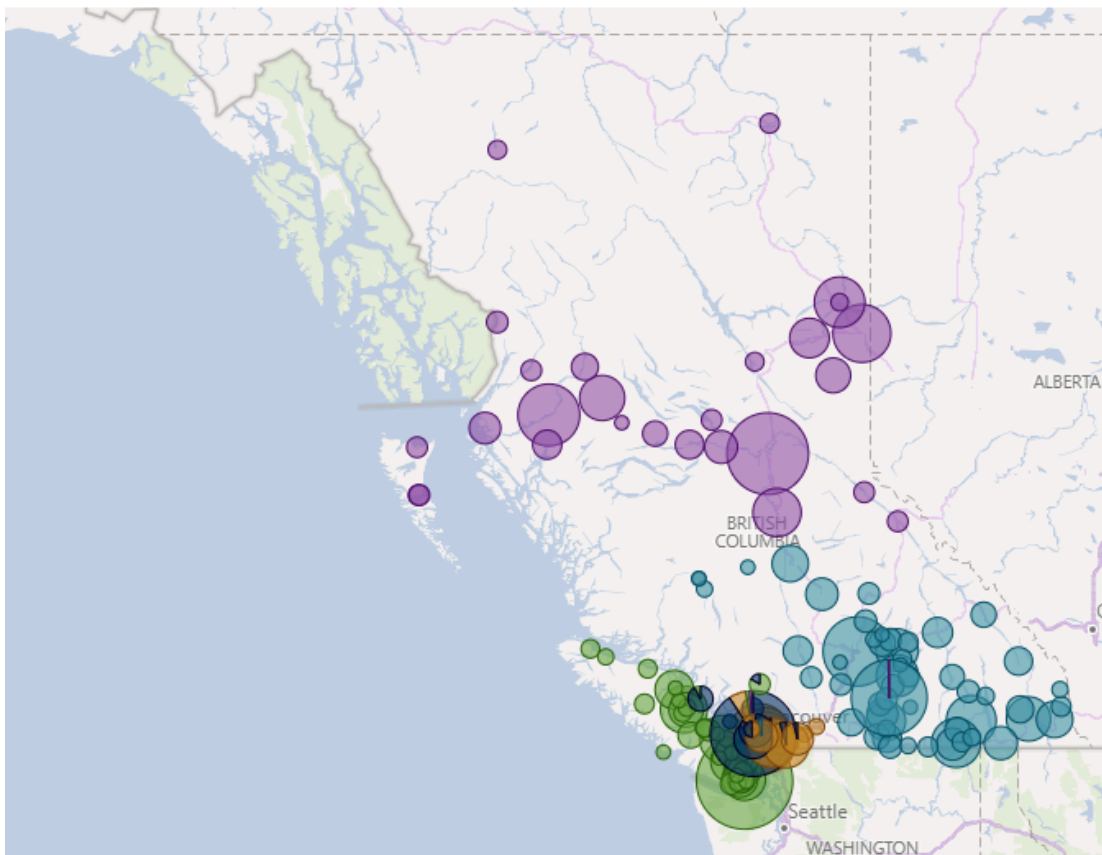

# What participants say about the service

**94% – 100%** of surveyed PAD participants “agreed” or “strongly agreed” that:

- They felt better informed when discussing medication options with patients
