NORTH VANCOUVER REAL ESTATE SALESPERSON SUSPENDED

VANCOUVER - Real Estate Salesperson, Daryl Wade Rusin, of North Vancouver has been suspended pending the completion of an investigation into allegations that Rusin had conducted himself in a manner prejudicial to the public, Superintendent of Real Estate, W. Alan Clark, announced today.

Rusin, who was licensed as a salesperson with Re/Max Crest Realty of North Vancouver, is prohibited from doing any real estate business while his suspension remains in effect.

The Suspension Order was issued Feb. 8, 2002, and may be appealed with the Commercial Appeals Commission.
