REALTOR SUSPENDED

VANCOUVER – The licence of Vernon realtor Derek Wesley Barnard has been suspended pending an investigation into allegations that he conducted himself in a manner prejudicial to the public, B.C.'s superintendent of real estate Alan Clark announced today.

Barnard, a salesperson with Vernon Property Management Ltd. is prohibited from doing any real estate business in British Columbia while suspended.

The suspension order was issued Jan. 13, 2003, and may be appealed with the Commercial Appeals Commission.
