2/ set adobe reader as the default program to open PDF file (following the steps below)

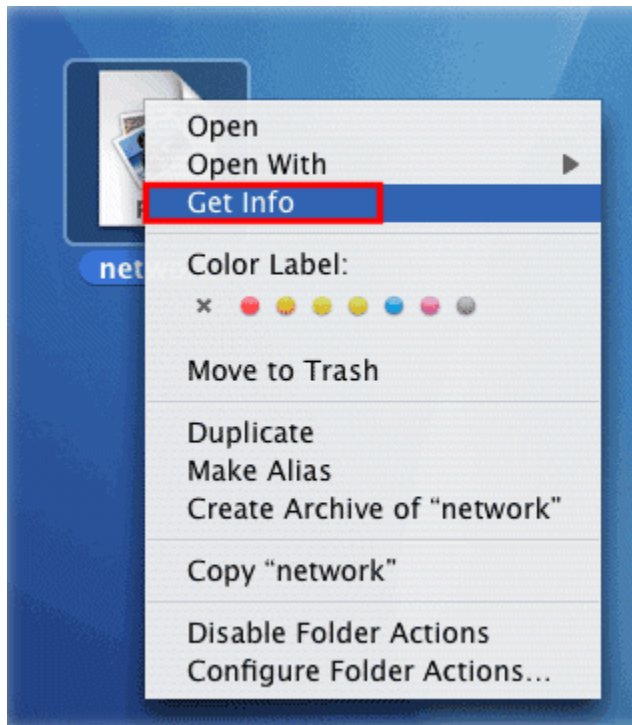
Set Adobe Acrobat as the Default PDF Reader in Mac OSX

Describes how to set Acrobat as the default PDF reader in a Mac

In OS X, Apple's *Preview* is the default application for opening a number of file types, including PDF's. While versatile, Preview will NOT allow you to make changes to PDF's with editable content. Follow these instructions to set Adobe Acrobat Reader as the default application for opening PDF files.

Step 1:

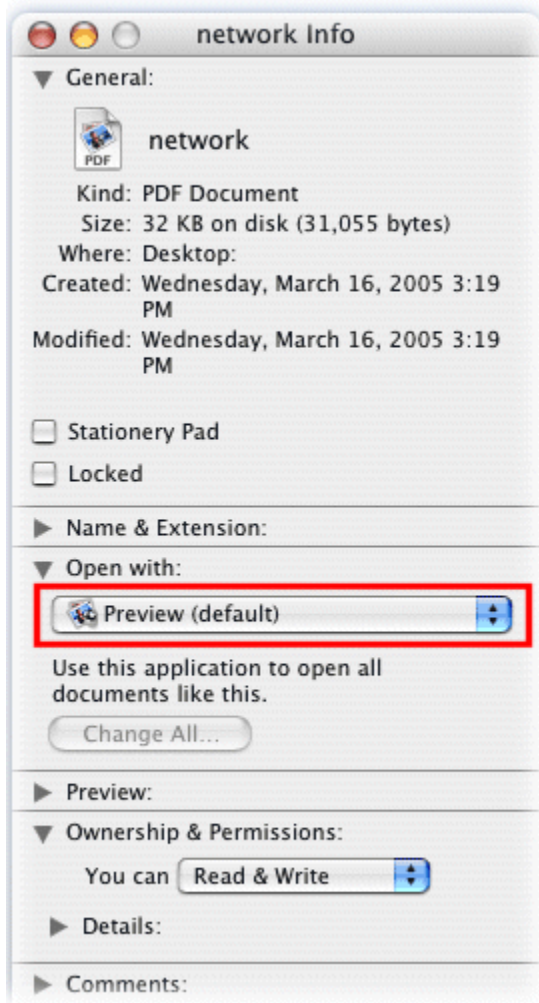
Single click a PDF file you wish to open or any PDF file in general while holding the Control key. Then select *GET INFO* from the menu you've opened.

Step 2:

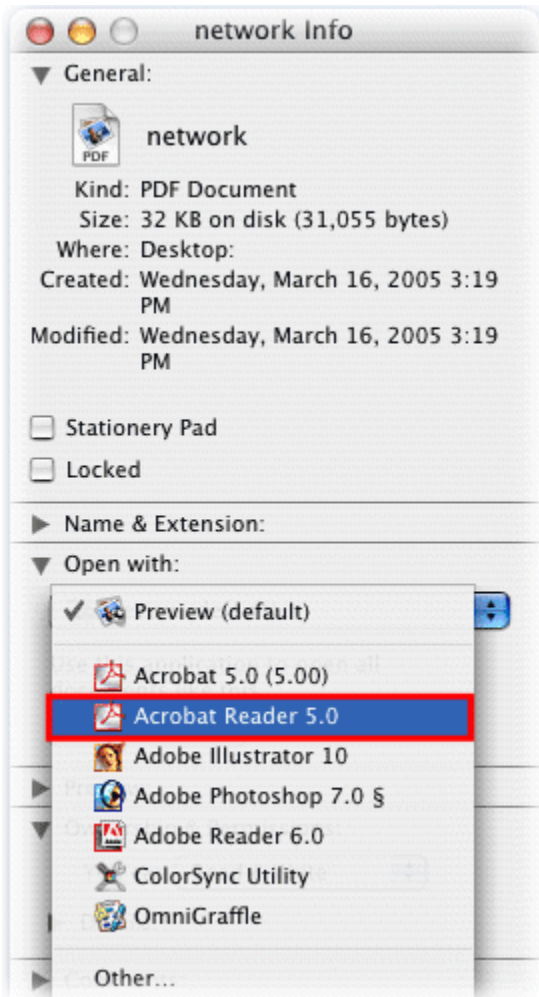
Click the drop down menu for *OPEN WITH*.

Select *ADOBE READER* from the menu.
