Dear Mr. Speaker:

This is a report regarding a regulation made on September 24, 2021 under the *COVID-19 Related Measures Act*, SBC 2020, c. 8 (CRMA). This report is presented pursuant to subsection 4 (2) of the CRMA.

Subsection 4 (4) of the CRMA requires that this report be laid before the Legislative Assembly as soon as possible.

The regulation will provide continued relief to the restaurant and hospitality sector in British Columbia impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic by extending the food service delivery fee cap that was set to expire 90 days after the lifting of the provincial state of emergency. The regulation will extend item 23.7 of schedule 2 until December 31, 2021.
