BC Prosecution Service Is Hiring Crown Counsel

Victoria – The BC Prosecution Service (BCPS) continues to need Crown Counsel to fill vacant positions in offices throughout BC.

As previously reported, in response to recent recruiting challenges, the BCPS is looking to fill up to 40 Crown Counsel positions this year. A recent nationally advertised hiring process got us about halfway there and allowed us to fill vacancies created by the dedication of 21 prosecutors and professional staff to new repeat violent offending coordinated response teams. We still need to fill positions vacated through attrition and retirement.

We are looking to hire hard-working, resilient, and fair-minded courtroom lawyers, with good common sense, solid experience, strong interpersonal skills, and practical life experience working and dealing with people from diverse groups, backgrounds, and circumstances.
