BC Prosecution Service approves *Motor Vehicle Act* charge against Surrey Police Service officer

Victoria – The BC Prosecution Service (BCPS) announced today that a charge of excessive speeding under the *Motor Vehicle Act* has been approved against Surrey Police Service Cst. Jared Cebryk in connection with an incident that occurred in Surrey on June 18, 2023.

An Information charging Cst. Cebryk with one count of excessive speeding contrary to section 148(1) of the *Motor Vehicle Act* was sworn on June 18, 2024, under Surrey Provincial Court file number 256972-1. The first appearance on this matter is scheduled for July 15, 2024, in Surrey Provincial Court.

The charge was approved by an experienced Crown Counsel with no prior or current connection with the officer. The charge assessment guidelines applied by the BCPS in reviewing all Reports to Crown Counsel are established in the BCPS Crown Counsel Policy Manual and are available online at:
