BC Prosecution Service approves charge against Vancouver special municipal constable

Victoria – The BC Prosecution Service (BCPS) announced today that a charge of assault has been approved against Vancouver Special Municipal Constable Omar Ahmed Flores following an incident that is alleged to have occurred at the Vancouver Police Department jail on January 1, 2023.

An Information charging Ahmed Flores with one count of assault contrary to section 266 of the *Criminal Code* was sworn on April 10, 2025, under Vancouver provincial court file number 274728-1. The first appearance on this matter is scheduled for April 16, 2025, in Vancouver provincial court.

The charges were approved by an experienced Crown Counsel who has no connection with the accused. The charge assessment guidelines applied by Crown Counsel in reviewing all Reports to Crown Counsel are established in the BC Prosecution Service Crown Counsel Policy Manual and are available online at:
