BC Prosecution Service approves charge against Vancouver Police Department officer

Victoria – The BC Prosecution Service (BCPS) announced today that a charge of assault has been approved against a Vancouver Police Department officer following an incident that occurred in Vancouver on September 9, 2025.

An Information charging Cst. Jason Grewal with one count of assault, contrary to section 266 of the *Criminal Code*, was sworn on September 3, 2026, under Vancouver Provincial Court file number 278593-1. The first appearance on this matter is scheduled for October 1, 2026.

The charges were approved by an experienced Crown Counsel who has no connection with the accused. The charge assessment guidelines applied by Crown Counsel in reviewing all Reports to Crown Counsel are established in the BC Prosecution Service Crown Counsel Policy Manual and are available online at:
