I am writing to provide you with an update on our procurement process for the upcoming 2018-19 fiscal year. As you are aware, all current contracts were extended to March 31, 2018.

At this time, the Community Safety and Crime Prevention Branch (CSCP) will not be proceeding with general open procurement activities for contracted victim services and violence against women programs. Instead, we plan to renew current contracts for another year to March 31, 2019.

The Branch will distribute the standard Program Application package sent to you in previous years for each contract with the CSCP Branch. *The Program Application package will be sent to your organization in mid-October and must be completed and returned to the Branch by January 15, 2018.*

We remain committed to ensuring all organizations are informed and prepared for any future changes to procurement processes well in advance.
